

Michigan Activity Pass Launches New Website

NOVI, Mich. – June 23, 2023 – The Michigan Activity Pass program launched a new website experience for library card holders this summer. Using your library card, you can check out a pass to parks, museums, attractions, and cultural destinations all throughout the state of Michigan.

A state-wide program housed by The Library Network, MAP offers library card holders over 450 unique destinations to receive free or reduced cost admission to their venues. Destinations range in offerings from historic sites and cultural attractions to parks and campgrounds.

On June 21, 2023, the new MAP website launched to the public with improvements for usability. Library card holders on desktop or mobile can now easily search for passes, filter results, and print or download a pass to Apple & Google Wallets to enter the destinations.
